Anne Roy McNab, listed as daughter to deceased Alexander MacNab, who was brother to John MacNab of Bovain, was a witness at the 1752 trial of James Stewart of the Glen (this trial was the basis for Robert Louis Stevenson's "Kidnapped").

Another witness was Bailveolin of Lismore, who would have been either Anne Roy's Uncle by marriage or her first cousin (Alexander's sister Mary married Campbell of Baileveolan).

The murder took place in Argyll - did Alexander go to Argyll? Or did his sister Mary take in his children after he died?

There is more than one version of Allan Napier Macnab's line of descent. This version, supposedly, was the local tradition.

The version in the official Clan History has him descended from Robert, son of Robert 14th Chief.

Archibald, 17th Chief, considered Allan Napier Macnab a candidate for Chief, but, according to contemporaneous writings, "Macnab never considered Sir Allan was entitled to be Chief by virtue of his being....next of kin. He only spoke of him as being Chief of the Clan on account of his work and ability".
